It all began more than 60 years ago, with Margarita Companc de Perez Acuña's dedicated heart to others. She was the true inspiration and left a mark that the generations of her family continue to follow today; a family committed to others and to their country. On April 6, 1959, Carlos and Jorge Perez Companc formally established our Foundation, which development was continued by their siblings Alicia and Gregorio.

We were created with two clear goals: the first one was to promote the study of nature, the functions, and responsibilities of business in the Christian social economic order. The second one was to address, under the same Catholic inspiration, the national needs of education, culture, and social assistance. These goals remain relevant today and have been expanded to provide opportunities to more people and communities.

Throughout this history, our foundation has supported multiple causes, organizations, and communities across the country. We contributed to creating and strengthening institutions of great relevance for Argentina; we assisted religious congregations in their evangelizing mission, aided dioceses in attending communities in contexts of social vulnerability, we promote the inclusion of people with disabilities, tackle the care and access to quality health and foster opportunities for education and teachers training, all aiming to contribute to a better quality of life.

Integrity, commitment, and a vocation for service were our origins, are our present and will always be our guiding light. This is why we want to leave a positive mark on every life we touch, living our values with pride, transmitting our legacy, and providing life changing opportunities.

Working model

Our approach: Our work is guided by a social and environmental focus, as well as the inclusion of people with disabilities. We also provide training for health teams and strengthen health institutions to achieve better quality of care.
